Qualifications: Membership in National Associations is mandatory for all age categories.

Competition rules: Valid WTF, ETU, and TAS rules. Electronic scoring system KPNP for all categories.

Deadline for Applications: At the Latest, May 21;st, 2025. at 24h Entries after the deadline will not be accepted.

Registration fee: KYORUGI - 40€, KICK - 20€, POOMSAE - single discipline 40€, two disciplines 50€, VIRTUAL TAEKWONDO - 30€. Payment is allowed at registration before weigh-in.



Changes: Competitors can't change the weight category after the application deadline. Also, competitors can't change the weight category after the official weigh-in. If the athlete registered online does not participate in the competition for some reason but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the deadline, his/her official team must fully pay his/her registration fee. The registration fee is not refundable at any time after the deadline.

Protest: Only the head of the team (official coach) has the right to protest immediately after the match. A protest fee of 50eur is to be paid, for every protest, to the Competition Board.

Responsibility: All competitors take part in the competition at their own responsibility. The organizer shall not be liable for resulting injury, damage, or loss of items and equipment. First Aid will be provided by the organizer. Bad behavior will be immediately sanctioned with the Disciplinary rules of TAS, ETU, and WTF. With the registration, the Participant/ Club acknowledges and accepts all the listed points.

Awards: Single awards 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places- one medal and diploma for each.

Team awards - Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Special award for the best competitor.

KICK

The Kick discipline is intended for competitors in the following age categories:

Categories:

Children 6-7 years old Children 8-9 years old Children 10-11 years old Cadets Juniors

There are no weight categories in this discipline, and boys and girls compete together within their respective age categories. The winner is determined after winning two rounds. In case of a tie, an additional third round will be held.

Competition Rules:

After each executed kick, the foot must touch the ground before performing the next kick. It is not allowed to touch the punching bag with hands. Competitors who do not follow the rules will be disqualified.

VIRTUAL TAKEWONDO

Categories:

- Children (m/f) Born in 2016., and 2017.
- Children (m/f) Born in 2014., and 2015.
- Cadets (m/ f) Born in 2011., 2012., and 2013.
- Juniors (m/ f) Born in 2008., 2009., and 2010.
- Seniors (m/f) From 2008., and before

Each match is a Best-of-3 rounds, with each round lasting a maximum of 60 seconds and 30 seconds rest between the rounds. The winner of each round will be decided when:

- An athlete totally depletes the Health Bar of the opposing athlete in the game within the timeframe;
- An athlete has a higher Health Bar than the opposing athlete when the time finishes;
- An athlete has been disqualified.



POOMSAE

Note: Competitions will be held only for recognized poomsae. No competitions in free style. Technical info: The competition is going to be held in TWO (2) classes:

- A class- black belts (1st DAN/Poom and higher) Except for children in A class (4th KUP and higher)
- B class color belts (from 8th 1st KUP).

Scores will be given by 5 referees, with the exclusion of the highest and lowest marks in both accuracy and presentation marks.

Pair competition: 2 athletes (m+f) Team competition: 3 athletes (m+m+m /f+f+)

The draw and the results: compulsory Poomsae. The draw and the results of the Poomsae will be performed by the competition board on <u>https://tms.vbs-sol.com/</u>

On principle, all members of a pair/team must be of the appropriate age. Exception: In the junior categor,y a pair/ team can consist of juniors and cadets, but in any case, they will have to compete in the Junior class.

System of Competition "A" CLASS - Cut off system

1st round Preliminary: When 20 or more contestants are participating: Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and a half from each group shall advance to the semi-final on the basis of their points. In the preliminary round, each group might be judged by a different group of judges. If the number of contestants is odd, then the number is rounded to be an even number, e.g. if there are 13 contestants in the group, 13 contestants are considered as 14 contestants and 7 contestants shall advance to semi-final.

2nd round Semi-final: When 9 to 19 contestants are participating: The competition shall start from semi-final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae and 8 of them shall advance to the final, on the basis of their points.

3rd round Final: When 8 or fewer contestants are participating: The competition shall start from the final round. Contestants shall perform two Poomsae, in accordance with the drawing of lots.

Note: The organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Poomsae to be performed in the preliminary and in semi-final round to 1 (one) form.

Procedure in case of equal score:

In case there is a tied score after the completion of the preliminary round, at the last place of the best 50%, respectively on the 8th rank of the semi-final round, the points in the presentation will be the determining factor for advancement to the next round. If this score is equal as well, all competitors in question will advance. In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, or 3, the contestant who is awarded more points in the presentation shall be declared as a winner. In case the score is still tied, the contestant who has more total points(including highest and lowest) shall be the winner. If the score is tied after the addition of the total points, competitors shall have a rematch. The referee will decide about the Poomsae to be performed (in any case it will be one of the compulsory Poomsae).

System of completition "B" CLASS

Ist round Preliminary: When 20 or more contestants are participating: IPoomsae Contestants shall perform the one assigned compulsory Poomsae and half of them from each group shall advance to the semifinal, on the basis of their points. In the preliminary round, each group can be judged by a different group of judges. If the number of contestants is odd, then the number is rounded to be an even number, eg if there are 13 contestants in the group, 13 contestants are considered as 14 contestants and 7 contestants will advance to the semifinals.

2nd round Semi-final: When 9 to 19 contestants are participating: I Poomsae, The competition shall start from semi-final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae and Sof them shall advance to the final, on the basis of their points.

3rd round Final: When 8 or fewer contestants are participating 1 Poomsae: The Competition shall start from the final round. Electronic scoring system.
