- Online registration at tkd-reg.com. Change of category after the application deadline is charged 3.600,00 RSD (30EUR).
- Registration is allowed only for recognized national federations.
- All competitors must have a proof of medical examination no older than 6 months.
- For children and cadets, the weigh-in tolerance is 100 grams.
- There is no weigh-in tolerance for juniors and seniors. If the competitor does not match the declared weight he is removed from the draw list.
- The use of foot protectors and headgear with face shield is mandatory for children and cadet categories (provided by the organizer).
- B-class competitors are not allowed to kick in the head area.
- Competitors compete at their own risk, and the organizer is not responsible for any injuries or loss of equipment or documents.
- Competitors under the age of 18 must have the written parental approval.
- Only licensed coaches for 2025 can sit on the coaching chair beside the court.
- Protest 6.000,00 RSD (50EUR).

- Electronic trunk protectors, headgear and foot protectors are provided by the organizer
- The daily accreditation fee for coaches and referees is 1000,00 RSD
- All violations of the rules of conduct and sports ethics will be sanctioned in accordance with the TAS Disciplinary Rules

POOMSAE

- Online registration at tkd-reg.com. Change of category after the application deadline is charged 3.600,00 RSD (30EUR).
- All competitors must have a proof of medical examination no older than 6 months.
- The competition will be held in two classes:

A class – black belts (1. Dan/Poom and higher)

B class – color belts (8 - 1 Geup)

- * exception: A class children 1 4. Geup and higher
- Registration is allowed only for recognized national federations.
- The B class Poomsae program for all age categories is given in the table competitors select
- Scores will be given by 5 referees, with exclusion of highest and lowest marks
- If a class A competitor does not complete the Poomsae given in the draw, the overall score will be reduced by 1.0 point.

COMPETITION RULES

A Class Poomsae - Torunament System:

- Competitors enter the mat simultaneously and perform against each other.
- Poomsae are randomly assigned according to current rules once competitors are on the mat.
- The winner of each match advances to the next round to face the winner from the corresponding bracket.

B Class Poomsae – Cut-off System:

- 20+ competitors: Each performs one Poomsae. The top 50% (rounded to an even number) advance to the semifinals.
- 9–19 competitors: Competition begins from the semifinals. Each performs one chosen Poomsae; the top 8 advance to the finals.
- 8 or fewer competitors: Competition starts directly from the finals. Each performs one chosen Poomsae; the top 4 are awarded, with both 3rd and 4th places receiving bronze medals.

NOTE: Due to the large number of competitors or lack of time, the organizer may change the qualification mode, so that instead of two mandatory poomse in each round, one given Poomsae may be performed in agreement with the Technical Committee for the A Class of competitors. In B class, the contestants perform one selected form in each round of the competition.

THE WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT

- The winner is the competitor who has the most points.
- In case of a tie, the winner will be the contestant who has received more points for the presentation.
- In case that the score is still tie, the winner is the one with the highest total of points (total points of all referees, including the highest and lowest marks).
- If case the result is still tie then an extra match will be made to determine the winner. The judge will choose the Poomsae to be scored.
- Again, one mandatory Poomsae is performed. The previous result will not affect the replay result.
- In case the result is tie after the Poomsae has been re-performed, the winner will be the competitor who has more points, including the highest and the lowest score.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE - RULES

Freestyle Poomsae is a performance, based on the Taekwondo techniques composition of music and choreography.

Composition of freestyle Poomsae

- Yeon-mu line will be selected by the contestant.
- Music and choreography will be selected by the contestant.
- The performance must be within the limits of the Tekvondo technique. The definition of Tekvondo technique will be determined by the TAS Refereeing Committee when the contestant submits a freestyle Poomsae. The plan is sent to the email: referee_poomsae@tas.org.rs by the end of the application deadline.
- Poomsae must contain the required elements (5). If one of the required elements is missing it will not be scored.
